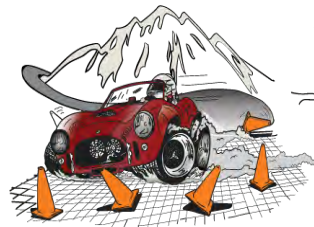

A NOTE FROM THE COMPETITION DIRECTORS

Hello Racers.

Greetings from the Comp Director's desk. Jared and I wanted to share a note of appreciation for a successful RCS 4. It was a great event and we wanted to say thank you for participating if you were able to make it. For those that could not be there...we missed you and hope to see you in July. This event was exceptionally warm, but everyone did a great job of keeping their cool. For those of us who volunteer our weekends to put these events on each month, it is a thrill to see everyone having fun and enjoying the track and cars. As competitors, we are equally concerned with getting bang for our buck so we are constantly on the lookout for ways to improve the quality of the event and increase track time. The track is currently managed by private company and there are a host of other clubs, events and business activities that compete for calendar space. We are considering options that would allow us to extend our use of the track on the days that we already pay rent – and by the way, track rental is \$500 per day! In addition to our track rent, we also participate in improvement initiatives with the track manager so that the time off track is pleasurable too. Ticket sales for our Race Car Giveaway and the TIF fee paid by drivers at each event contribute to this fund. Speaking of the Race Car Giveaway, that is exactly one month away. We will be drawing the winner at the end of the July event and, even though the winner need not be present, we'd love to see everyone out there for that. Finally, we are planning 8 AM starts for the July and August events; driver meetings for those two events will be at 7:45 on race day. We're hoping this earlier start will help us get additional runs in while avoiding some of the afternoon heat.

Did You Know?

Our events are dedicated to the fun and entertainment of autocrossers from all of over the region. We are committed to maximizing track time and putting on a safe and smooth-running event. Track workers are needed on both practice day and race day. Saturday workers will be assigned at registration for start-gate duties. Our insurance requires gate control when the track is open. Thanks for helping!

Q and A

Q. Can I run my drift car at your events?

A. Cars of all types are welcome to run with the Siskiyou Sports Car Club. Cars must pass a tech inspection. We allow one car on the track at a time running at the safest maximum speed in a fully controlled manner. Drifting of any type is not permitted at our events.

Q. Are Karts allowed at your events?

A. SSCC allows licensed drivers to run anything from street cars to formula cars. Unlicensed drivers under age 16 can run karts as long as an adult is present at the track with that driver.

43rd Rogue Challenge Series (RCS) Point Standings - June 2017

The RCS consists of 7 events, April through September. Only 6 of them will be counted for points, so if you attend all 7 events, the event with the lowest number of points will be thrown out. To qualify for the championship awards, a person needs to have participated in at least 4 of the events, in the same class. Points are awarded as: 1st place=9 pts, 2nd=6 pts, 3rd=4 pts, 4th=3 pts, 5th=2 pts, beyond 6th and DNF=1 pt.
