Rogue Spartans Racing is now Warriors On Track Pac-West, a division of Warriors On Track.

As everyone may have noticed, some changes have happened at Rogue Spartans Racing over the off season. Forming a non-profit is extremely expensive and complex, and it just happened that our paths crossed with the right person at the right time to bring this to fruition.

In December, Bryan and Sean traveled to Thunderhill to watch Derek DeBoer drive, as well as feel things out for the possibility of running it ourselves in the future. In the pit next to his, a banner was hanging for a group called Warriors On Track. Upon investigation we met Tom Woods, the founder. Turns out he had a similar vision to ours but was taking vets to races and including them in pit crews, whereas we were taking vets racing. After some discussion, a proposal to join forces was made, and we were on our way.

Warriors On Track applied to be a non-profit in Oregon with Bryan as the authorized agent. He's also being added to the board of directors. We in Oregon will be running most of the competition and on track activities. A large part of that will be with the SSCC and autocross. We'll be bringing in veterans to work with us a day or two before the autocross weekend, they will receive instruction on track and then turned loose to set their own times. It will be the first step to being further involved with us in the faster cars on bigger tracks.

The Pinto will return! We received news yesterday (April 25) that the large donation we'd been waiting for had finally come through, which will enable us to finish the Pinto and also purchase a 2006 Mustang that was raced in the NASA Camaro Mustang Challenge series. We plan on using that car for most of the bigger track engagements.

Some may have noticed the car Bryan was driving this month...While the chassis has a future with WOT, the engine has to be sold before it can be worked into the program. Bryan will continue to campaign the car through the season, though it will be a bit less offending to the ears than it was but still too much car for a beginner to jump in and try to drive.

We appreciate everyone's continued support and look forward to this season and many more in the future.
