### **2021 COVID-19 Guidelines**

With the current state of affairs with Covid-19, we, as an organization, are at the mercy of the ever-evolving situation. We recognize the severity of what has been a “Global Pandemic”. We all want to enjoy the camaraderie and thrills of autocrossing, but must do so while keeping everyone’s health and safety in mind. More than anything, we are asking that everyone acts properly and with respect for others. With that, as the state guidelines and restrictions change, we have adopted the following to adhere to at our events.

#### **GUIDELINES**

- All individuals must check in at the registration table to receive a wristband. Drivers will enter the event and all others will sign the Covid-19 tracking list.
- Please do not attend this event if you: 1) have a fever, cough, feel short of breath or have any other Covid-19 symptoms 2) have knowingly been exposed to a communicable disease such as Covid-19 3) have traveled to or from a highly impacted area within the last two weeks 4) have been in contact with anyone who has traveled out of the country within the last two weeks.
- Observe social distancing separation of 6 feet when not wearing masks.
- Masks are required when not in your pit area or in your car.
- Helmets will be rented only once a day and will be sanitized after use.
- Drivers may take one passenger when making a run on the track but that rider must be a guest of the driver. Both must wear a mask or a full-coverage helmet.
- When your group is not driving, stay off the grid and act as a spectator.
- All those in attendance are to bring their own food and drinks. No food or water will be available at the race site.
- Blatant disregard of these guidelines may result in any individual being asked to leave the venue.
- Any attendee who experiences COVID-19 symptoms after the event, must immediately notify a club officer, who will notify all other attendees of the potential exposure.
