### GUIDELINES

1. Social Distancing, **6 ft** of separation between Participant/Drivers, Event Staff and Spectators is required before, during and after the event.
  2. Masks are required when not in your vehicle or your own pit area before, during and after the event.
  3. All individuals not participating as a driver must check in with registration and have a wristband and sign into the State Covid19 Tracking List.
  4. Tow Vehicles, trailers and vehicles entered to race will be allowed into the gated area on Friday night.
  5. Participants/Drivers will be allowed to enter and park within the gated area.
    - a. Early Bird Participant/Drivers need to stay off grid and act as a Spectator
  6. Blatant disregard of SSCC’s predetermined guidelines may result in any individual being asked to leave the venue.
- There will be no food or drinks provided- Please bring your own.
  - There will be weekend rental helmets available only.
  - Ride-alongs with **drivers’ guests only – all other ride-alongs prohibited**
  - Participant/Drivers can register for all day Saturday *AND/OR* all day Sunday
  - This is a for-points event
